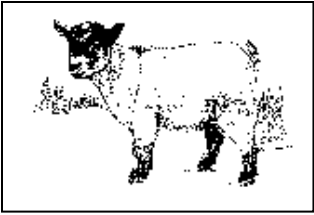


## ANOTHER BLOOMING GOAT SHOW

Only animals with original registration papers are allowed to show in sanctioned classes. This show is part of the Washington State Goat Breeders Association's annual events.

**ARRIVAL:** anytime after 8:30 am.

**CHECK-IN:** 9:00 am

**SHOW TIME:** 10:00 a.m.

**HEALTH CHECK:** Do not bring animals with obvious signs of illness (runny nose, visible sores, lice, diarrhea, etc.) Health checks will be performed by EPGA members. No refunds for failed health checks. To help assure microchips are readable, EPGA members doing health check will scan for microchips if requested by owner.

**ENTRY FEES:** Due to cost overruns for this show ONLY, we will increase entry fees to **\$9.00 per animal**, \$3.00 prospect wethers, \$3.00 showmanship. Entries must be postmarked by March 20th to avoid late fees of \$3.00 per animal. No refunds will be given. Payment in full must be enclosed with entry.

**PEN FEES:** no pens provided

**RAFFLE:** Please bring raffle items as the raffle helps off-set the cost of the show. Advance raffle tickets are available at 4 for \$1.00 (please see entry form). **Class 1.** Primary - 7 years and under

**Class 2.** Junior - 8 to under 11 years

**Class 3.** Intermediate - 11 to under 14 years

**Class 4.** Senior - 14 to under 18 years

**Class 5.** Adult - 18 years and older

**WETHERS**

**Class 6.** Prospect Wethers (Only bucklings under 5 months of age may be entered. Not eligible for Best Wether)

**Class 7.** Birth to under 6 months

**Class 8.** 6 months to under 1 year

**Class 9.** 1 to under 2 years

**Class 10.** 2 to under 4 years

**Class 11.** 4 years and older

**BEST WETHER and RESERVE BEST WETHER**

**Class 17.** Senior Doe Kids unfreshened - 10 to under 12 months

**Class 18.** Yearling Does unfreshened - 12 to under 15 months

**Class 19.** Jr. Yearling Does unfreshened- 15 to under 18 months

**Class 20.** Int. Yearling Does unfreshened - 18 to under 21 months

**Class 21.** Sr. Yearling Does unfreshened- 21 to under 24 months

**Class 30.** Sr. Baby Buck Kids - 2 to under 4 months

**Class 31.** Junior Buck Kids - 4 to under 6 months

**Class 32.** Jr. Intermediate Buck Kids - 6 to under 8 months

**Class 33.** Sr. Intermediate Buck Kids - 8 to under 10 months

**Class 34.** Senior Buck Kids - 10 to under 12 months
