ENTRY FEES: EPGA Members \$9.00 per entry, per show. Non Members \$10.00 per entry per show. All showmanship classes \$3.00. \$2.00 additional fee for late entries postmarked after March 12th. 1 change within the same class at no charge. **Any additional changes made after March 12th must be made at the show and will be charged a late fee.** No Exceptions. No refunds of entry fees will be made unless a 24 hour cancellation notice is received. All returned checks will be charged an additional \$25.00. Payment of entry must be paid in full and enclosed with entry form

PEN FEES: No pens are available if you choose to stage your crates in the barn please. Have tarps down to collect any straw or droppings. EPGA members are responsible for barn clean up after the show any and all help is appreciated.
